A colleague today was asked if the colour of "fire brigade" had changed from red to yellow. He said that it had. I cannot find any reference to a change of colour, so I suspect he was telling the truth, but the question is: why? A: According to this page, the UK fire brigade was first colored red: In 1843, the first red uniforms appeared in Edinburgh and Stirling. At around the same time, the London Fire Brigade was given a red uniform. In 1853, the General Fire Office of London, which included the London Fire Brigade, the Metropolitan Fire Brigade and the Metropolitan Police Fire Brigade, decided to change the color of the uniforms to red because of the former scarlet color, which was fading. The exact history of the color change is unknown to me, but Wikipedia's article on the topic says that in the late 19th century the color red was considered as inappropriate as yellow, because of the perception that red indicates danger (which is obviously true, if you look at red traffic lights) so they tried yellow and orange, but that the yellow did not stick either, so now they're back to red.
