Most phrasal verbs are similar to regular verbs in that they do not have an infinitive form. If the action is continued, then it will be required that the -ing form be used. However, phrasal verbs don't have to have an object; therefore, the object can be implied or left out, or the phrasal verb may have a noun substitute, which can be used instead. The use of the -ing form, with either a direct object or indirect object, is similar to that in English. For example, using the object with the regular verb give or the phrasal verb get can be done using give or get, respectively. Similarly, if a person uses give, they can use get instead, and visa versa. Also, the tense of the verb used with get can be left out if the implied object is obvious. For example, if you are in a hurry, you can say "let's get go". Examples of phrasal verbs Anaphoric Anaphoric phrasal verbs take the object of the main verb, and continue the action by making reference to that object. One such phrasal verb is to make, which is used to extend the action that has already been carried out. When one makes something, they extend the action of making. 1. He made a good dinner. (main verb) 2. The students made a mess in the classroom. (anaphoric) 3. She made him laugh by surprising him with her new hairstyle. (anaphoric) Non-anaphoric Phrasal verbs are used in a similar way in English to refer to actions where the object is implied or omitted. For example, you can use let's go to mean "Let's go" and you can use let's get it to mean "Let's get it". 1. Let's go and relax. 2. I'll get it and then let's go. 3. Let's get it and go. Common Examples include: To help: Helping can be done with the regular verb help. In this case, the object is not actually shown: "We can help you." Instead, they are referring to the action itself. 2. We can help you. Postpositive Postpositive phrasal verbs create an action at the end of a sentence. They are usually used when you want
